### VENUE

This scientific event will take place at the Hotel da Régua, Régua (Portugal).

### AIM

The aim of this meeting is to provide a forum for discussion of recent results in the field of *Medicinal Chemistry*, particularly concerning the development of novel anticancer agents and target-oriented strategies, such as new immunological and gene therapy approaches. A strong interplay is expected between academic researchers and clinical practitioners, in a feedback aimed at translating elemental research into innovative therapeutic protocols.

The meeting is thus intended to assemble multidisciplinary scientists from different areas (Bioorganic, Bioinorganic and Physical Organic Chemistry, Biochemistry, Biology, Bioinformatics Pharmacology, Pharmacy and Medicine) representing distinct perspectives related to molecular aspects of cancer therapy. Its intimate character and social program is intended to stimulate interactions and discussion among academic and non-academic researchers.

### SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The scientific programme will comprise plenary lecturers (60 min), invited lectures (30 min), short orals (15 min) and posters. Pharmaceutical companies will also be invited to participate, in a business symposium.

The oral lectures are strongly encouraged to be presented in english. The abstracts and slides are required to be in english, as well as the posters.
