## **Ph.D. position in Biopharmaceutical Sciences**

Research of the group of Biopharmaceutical Sciences at the University of Geneva is focused on molecular biopharmaceutics, with special attention paid to the mucosal application of (DNA) vaccines. The project will focus on the development and testing of inhalable carrier systems for vaccines against tuberculosis.

The work will involve modern biochemical, molecular and cell biological techniques. As the project will require the interaction with partners in Europe and Asia, communicative skills, including fluency in the English language, are required from the candidate.

Candidates will also take part in the Doctoral School in Pharmaceutical Sciences and will be involved in undergraduate teaching at the Ecole de Pharmacie Geneve-Lausanne (EPGL).

The candidate should hold a diploma or M.Sc. in (Bio)Pharmaceutical Sciences, Biology or related areas. Experience in cell culture techniques and experimental animal work is an advantage. Fluency in the English language is required, knowledge in French is desired.
